IL FUTURO

IN INGLESE CI SONO VARI MODI DI ESPRIMERE IL FUTURO. L'AZIONE PUO' ESSERE INTENZIONALE, PIANIFICATA, VOLONTARIA O PUO' ESSERE INDIPENDENTE DALLA VOLONTA' DI CHI PARLA.

TRE MODI PER ESPRIMERE IL FUTURO:

1) CON WILL + INFINITO DEL VERBO

Quando si parla di fatti futuri e non viene specificato se si sia presa una decisione. Quando si parla di cose che accadranno in futuro indipendentemente dalla volontà di chi parla. Per fare delle previsioni.

Quando si prende una decisione sul momento.

Esempi:

I'm sure she will go to the party with you. The school year will finish on 12th June. The weather will be very cold next week.

2) CON BE + GOING TO + INFINITO DEL VERBO

Quando si parla di intenzioni, di qualcosa che il soggetto ha deciso di fare. Quando c'è qualcosa nel presente che ci fa prevedere un'azione o evento futuri. Per indicare un'azione o evento che sta per accadere.

Esempi:

She is going to buy a new car.
I'm going to have a party next week.
"Look at those clouds! It's going to rain soon!"

3) CON IL PRESENT CONTINUOUS USATO IN SENSO DI FUTURO

Quando ci si riferisce a qualcosa che è stato organizzato, pianificato, o concordato. E' sempre seguito da un'espressione di tempo determinato.

Esempi:

What are you doing tonight? She is leaving at 3.00 p.m. They are staying at home tomorrow.

N.B. Per parlare di orari o programmi (es. cinema, teatro, ecc...) si può usare il present simple: What time does the next train to London leave?

It leaves at 11.43.

Il present continuous con senso di futuro è spesso accompagnato da una espressione di tempo futuro, una data o un orario specifico (tomorrow = domani, at 7.00 a.m., tonight = stasera, next week = la prossima settimana, ecc...).
