

## PRESENT SIMPLE

Il PRESENT SIMPLE indica un'ABITUDINE, una ROUTINE, qualcosa che succede SEMPRE, MAI, QUALCHE VOLTA, SPESSO, UNA VOLTA ALLA SETTIMANA, DUE VOLTE AL MESE, ECC...

### TO PLAY

**AFFIRMATIVE FORM = SOGGETTO + VERBO**

I PLAY  
YOU PLAY  
HE PLAYS   
SHE PLAYS   
IT PLAYS   
WE PLAY  
YOU PLAY  
THEY PLAY

**NEGATIVE FORM = SOGGETTO + DO/DOES + VERBO**

I **DO NOT (DON'T)** PLAY  
YOU **DO NOT (DON'T)** PLAY  
HE **DOES NOT (DOESN'T)** PLAY  
SHE **DOES NOT (DOESN'T)** PLAY  
IT **DOES NOT (DOESN'T)** PLAY  
WE **DO NOT (DON'T)** PLAY  
YOU **DO NOT (DON'T)** PLAY  
THEY **DO NOT (DON'T)** PLAY

**INTERROGATIVE FORM = DO/DOES + SOGGETTO + VERBO**

**DO** I PLAY?  
**DO** YOU PLAY?  
**DOES** HE PLAY?  
**DOES** SHE PLAY?  
**DOES** IT PLAY?  
**DO** WE PLAY?  
**DO** YOU PLAY?  
**DO** THEY LVE?

### SHORT ANSWERS

YES, S + DO / DOES.

NO, S + DON'T / DOESN'T

**Esempi:** I like chocolate. (Mi piace sempre)  
She PLAYS in London. (Ci vive sempre)  
I don't play football. (Non gioco mai a calcio)  
She doesn't play football. (Non gioca mai a calcio)  
Do you like chocolate? Yes, I do. / No, I don't  
Does she like chocolate? Yes, she does. / No she doesn't.
