II PRESENT SIMPLE indica un'ABITUDINE, una ROUTINE, qualcosa che succede SEMPRE, MAI, QUALCHE VOLTA, SPESSO, UNA VOLTA ALLA SETTIMANA, DUE VOLTE AL MESE, ECC...

TO PLAY

AFFIRMATIVE FORM = SOGGETTO + VERBO

I PLAY YOU PLAY HE PLAY<u>S</u> SHE PLAY<u>S</u> IT PLAY<u>S</u> WE PLAY YOU PLAY THEY PLAY

NEGATIVE FORM = SOGGETTO + DO/DOES + VERBO

I DO NOT (DON'T) PLAY YOU DO NOT (DON'T) PLAY HE DOES NOT (DOESN'T) PLAY SHE DOES NOT (DOESN'T) PLAY IT DOES NOT (DOESN'T) PLAY WE DO NOT (DON'T) PLAY YOU DO NOT (DON'T) PLAY THEY DO NOT (DON'T) PLAY

INTERROGATIVE FORM = DO/DOES + SOGGETTO + VERBO

DO I PLAY?	
DO YOU PLAY?	SHORT ANSWERS
DOES HE PLAY?	YES, S + DO / DOES.
DOES SHE PLAY?	NO, S + DON'T / DOESN'T
DOES IT PLAY?	
DO WE PLAY?	
DO YOU PLAY?	
DO THEY LVE?	Esempi: I like chocolate. (Mi piace sempre)
	She PLAYs in London. (Ci vive sempre)
