THE PASSIVE

La forma passiva si costruisce con il verbo **TO BE + PAST PARTICIPLE (participio passato)** del verbo principale. Il **PAST PARTICIPLE dei verbi regolari** si costruisce aggiungendo il suffisso – **ED** alla forma base del verbo, con le variazioni ortografiche uguali alle forme del past simple (looked, played, used, opened). Il **PAST PARTICIPLE dei verbi irregolari** è la **terza forma** del paradigma. Esempio: MAKE – MADE – **MADE**; SEE – SAW – **SEEN**; WRITE – WROTE – **WRITTEN**. Il complemento di termine è introdotto dalla preposizione **BY**.
